SECTION 1. Amendment

Section 5 (Definitions) of Local Law No. 1 of the year 2001 is hereby amended so as to add an additional paragraph thereto which shall read as follows:

(D) "Habitual", as used in this Local Law, means a dog howling, barking, crying or whining for repeated intervals of at least ten (10) minutes with less than two (2) minutes of interruption, which can be heard by any person, including a law enforcement officer or dog control officer, from a location outside of the owner's or caretaker's premises.

SECTION 2. Ratification

Except as herein amended, all of the other provisions contained in Local Law No. 1 of the year 2001 are hereby ratified, affirmed and continued.

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its being filed with the Secretary of State.
