This includes each floor and garage. (Basement should not be included.)	
Minimum Residential Permit Application Fee-----	\$50.00
Commercial Building Permit Application Fee-----	\$20.00 per 100 Sq.Ft.
Minimum Commercial Permit Application Fee-----	\$100.00
Agricultural Farm Building(s) other than Homes-----	\$4.00 per 100 Sq.Ft.
Single Wide Mobile Homes (within parks or on private lots) -----	\$ 50.00
Double Wide Mobile Homes (within parks or on private lots) -----	\$ 75.00
Mobile Home Permits do not include septic systems. Separate Septic Permit must be applied for.	
Sewage System Permits (new or repairs) -----	\$ 50.00
Outdoor Wood Boilers-----	\$ 75.00
Swimming Pools -----	\$ 50.00
Fire Safety Inspections -----	\$ 25.00
Business Certificates -----	\$ 30.00
Demolition Permit -----	\$ 30.00
Renewal of any permit issued (Application to renew must be in writing) -----	\$ 25.00

Mobile Home Park Annual Renewal Fee (11 to 100 lot) -----	\$100.00 + \$2.50 per lot
Mobile Home Park Annual Renewal Fee (over 100 lots) -----	\$200.00 + \$2.50 per lot
Single Lot added to Mobile Home Park (must also apply to Planning Board) -----	\$ 50.00
Double Lot added to Mobile Home Park (must also apply to Planning Board) -----	\$ 75.00
Application to Zoning Board of Appeals -----	\$ 75.00
Application to Planning Board for Site Plan -----	\$175.00
Application to Planning Board for Sign Permit -----	\$ 50.00
Application to Planning Board for New Occupancy in Existing Building -----	\$100.00
Application to Planning Board for Subdivisions-----	\$ 175.00 plus \$ 50.00 per lot
